Harry Dobson, chairman of Kirkland Lake Gold Inc, says a new type of gold mineralisation for the Kirkland Lake area has been intersected in underground drilling at the New South zone at the operation. The mineralisation is associated with sulphides, rather than hosted by quartz veins as typical in the rest of the area, according to the company. The better of the recent results from holes testing the new zone are as follows:
